

## Citizen Wildlife Monitoring Project Equipment Checklist

### Supplies Provided by Conservation Northwest:

- Wildlife remote camera(s) (usually 2 per team) and camera manual
- GPS unit and GPS manual
- 2 memory cards per camera
- Python cable locks (one per camera) and keys to unlock python lock
- 2 small masterlocks with keys
- Lockbox (one for each Bushnell camera)
- Replacement batteries for camera(s) and for GPS
- Ziploc bags for memory cards and equipment
- Lure
- Maps of camera location and directions/navigation instructions
- Field data sheet, small clipboard, and writing utensil
- Thick, black marker and sheet of paper for index photo
- Latex gloves, paper bag, mini envelopes for specimen collection-- **no plastic bags for specimen collection**
- Appropriate research permit if necessary
- Camera check protocol
- Background Guide to Species in the Washington Cascades
- Site description document

### Supplies not provided by Conservation Northwest but highly recommended:

- Folding saw or pruners to clear branches
- Windex to clean camera lens
- Compass
- 10 essentials (especially backcountry cameras)
- Adequate clothing and shoes for hiking in various weather conditions
- Food and water
- Other tools like hammer and screwdriver in case you have to fix or remove cameras
- Digital camera for photographing wildlife, tracks, scat, animal markings, etc
- Scales to include in tracking photographs
- Other recommended wildlife tracking guides
